GeezerJock Magazine Announces the 2006 GeezerJock of the Year Award

2006 GeezerJock of the Year

In its December 2006 issue, *GeezerJock* magazine unveiled the winner of the **Michelob ULTRA GeezerJock of the Year** award. Racquetball player **Ruben Gonzalez**, a 54-year-old from Staten Island, New York won the award which recognizes superior achievements by athletes 40 years of age or older.

Ruben Gonzalez, a grandfather of four, still plays on the **IRT Pro Tour**. Gonzalez made an unexpected run through the brackets, defeating two top-ten players while advancing to the quarterfinals at the **2006 Motorola IRT Pro Nationals**. Gonzalez also won the Men's 45+ and Men's 50+ age groups at the **Ektelon USA Racquetball National Singles Championships** in May, 2006. "Coming out of Spanish Harlem as a handball hustler who discovered racquetball and became Number One in the world, Gonzalez is a fantastic story. That he's still excelling at age 54 only makes the tale more amazing," said Sean Callahan, the magazine's editor.

The **GeezerJock of the Year** award program also recognizes the **GeezerJock Association Executive of the Year**, as well as ten age-group winners - a male and female athlete in each of five age categories, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79 and 80 plus.

2006 GeezerJock Executive of the Year, Steve Sigler founded the Men's Senior Baseball League in 1985. The league is based in Melville, New York and has grown from a handful of players to more than 45,000 playing hardball in leagues across the country. 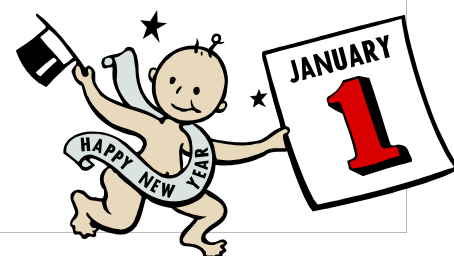

18th IRF World Junior Championships

The USA hosted the 18th World Junior Championships in Tempe, Arizona on December 16 - 21, 2006. More than 300 junior athletes from around the world met to battle for the title of World Champion. Team Mexico won the championship for the third consecutive year with a 28-point-difference over Team USA. USA girls team members scored almost dead even with the Mexico girls team members at 122 to 129 points. The USA boys team members' point difference was slightly more widespread at 141 to Mexico's 162 points.



Many South American countries are rapidly improving their racquetball games and the United States will have to maintain a dedicated and diligent junior program to remain competitive in this arena, according Luke St. Onge, Secretary General of the International Racquetball Federation.

The 15th annual **Christmas Classic ProAm Racquetball Championships**, held December 8 - 10 at the Crystal Gateway Sport & Health Club in Arlington, Virginia was filled with upsets. **Cheryl Gudinas Holmes**, the tournament's #1 seed was defeated in the quarterfinals by #9 seed **Doreen Fowler**. **Rhonda Rajsich**, the #2 seed, also fell in the quarterfinals losing to the #10 seed, **Samantha Salas**. **Kerri Wachtel** defeated **Angela Grisar** in the finals in three straight games, 6, 6, 8.

The **WPRO** kicked off 2007 at the **Emerald City Open** on January 4 - 7, 2007, in Seattle, Washington. USA Racquetball National Rules Commissioner, **Otto Dietrich** answers the following question:

"Is slinging or carrying the ball legal?"

Otto's Ruling:

Although you may have heard that this is an "old" rule, the rule regarding carrying the ball still exists; it is *still* illegal to carry the ball. (Official Rules of Racquetball 3.13.c.10).

Jack Huczek (#1) captured the title at the **2007 Orange County Open** with his defeat over (#2) **Jason Mannino** (3), 4, 8, 7. The event, hosted by the **Los Cab Sports and Racquet Club**, **January 11 - 14**, was sponsored by One Shot International.

In other **IRT** news, **Rocky Carson** has signed a long-term endorsement with **Ektelon**. Carson, nicknamed the "California Kid" by his peers, earned the designation as one of the top juniors to ever play the game. Carson began his professional career with **Ektelon** at age 15. He is recognized as the **top outdoor player in the world**,



dominating the outdoor circuit during the past three years and winning nearly every major tournament in the sport including the **Ektelon/WOR Championships** two of the past three years. Carson is the only male player in the sport to win **national indoor singles and doubles championships** and the **national outdoor singles championship** in the same year.
